



CMCBA Hive Grant Recipient Agreement 2019

Hive grant recipients will:

- Join CMCBA for 3 years and TBA for the first 2 years of beekeeping
- Attend a CMCBA beginner beekeeper course, typically held in the month of February, or any other qualifying Beginning Beekeeper course, or course taught by another TBA club
- Volunteer 5 hours a year for 2 years at a CMCBA function
- Register their hive(s)
- Sign the Best Management Practices Agreement
- Find an approved mentor from CMCBA for the first 2 years of keeping bees.
- Be responsible for the purchase of any additional supplies needed for their apiary, beyond the contents of the grant
- Attend a minimum of 8 out of 10 monthly meetings in the first year of membership PRIOR to qualifying for the hive grant the following year
- If, once receiving the hive grant, the grantee decides they no longer desire to or are unable to fulfill the requirements, the grantee will either: 1. Return all hive equipment included in the grant, or 2. Refund the total cost spent by CMCBA for the grant
- Should the grantee not return the equipment or total cost within 18 months of failing to fulfill the requirements, CMCBA will pursue legal recourse
