

Clarksville-Montgomery County Beekeeping Association (CMCBA)
First Annual **Celebration of Pollinators Calendar Application**

CMCBA is working on a calendar that will celebrate our area's vital pollinators with the goal of encouraging the community to engage with nature and take a proactive self-paced educational tour of our local pollinators and pollinator friendly environments. Each month will feature a photograph or artwork. Submissions will be juried to determine which pictures to feature each month, as well as on the cover. There is no charge to submit an entry and no prize money will be awarded. No more than 2 entries per artist. Calendars will be sold as a fundraiser for the CMCBA and its partners to plan and provide educational opportunities within the community in the future about the health of the area's pollinators.

Applicants should observe healthy pollinator habitats in our area and recognize all pollinators, their significance in the environment, their diversity, and the healthy environments in which they can survive. While studying the area pollinators an applicant is encouraged to take photographs and/or create art pieces (in any art medium) appropriate for a month of the calendar. Photos and other art must feature pollinators of Montgomery County, Tennessee or the surrounding area. Photo/art must include a pollinator (examples: Bee, Wasp, Moth, Fly, Beetle); art with humans represented will not be accepted.

Entry may be an original photograph (without watermarks), painting, drawing, or mixed media/collage and must be the original work of the artist in both design and concept, completed within the past 18 months & not entered in another event. Artwork cannot be copied, in part or whole, from any published or copyrighted work. Compositions from published photographs not taken by the artist or images derived from other artist's work are not considered original and are ineligible.

Submitted images must be in jpeg or jpg format with at least a 300 dpi resolution submitted by email to HealthyPollinators@gmail.com. Since the calendar is a wall calendar, submitted images should be horizontally oriented. The deadline for submitting an entry is 4:00 PM on Monday, November 30, 2020.

Artwork will be juried by a team of judges. Recognition will be given for participation. Featured works will list the name of the artist/ photographer, the general location the pollinator was viewed, date viewed, the pollinator species, and other interesting information submitted. You will be contacted if your work is selected.
